"The final had a bit of a different look as both teams played in their costumes on the afternoon of Halloween. However, the results were the same, as the Gaels offense was able to manufacture runs, and the pitching and defense were able to keep the potent Phoenix offense from ever getting going. Dylan Chavez took the mound for the Gaels

In the fourth, the Gaels were able to get to Keane and take control of the lead. Kalfus led off with a double, and Amerongen followed with a double of his own, scoring Kalfus. Heinzer's bat stayed hot with an infield single, moving Amerongen to third, and redshirt freshman James Palmer battled and knocked him in with a single, chasing Keane. Junior Alex Schmarzo came in to stop the bleeding, but Reynolds greeted him with a two-run double. After advancing to third on the throw home, he came across on a passed ball, giving the Gaels a commanding 6-2 lead.

The runs scored by the Gaels in the fourth proved to be all they would need, as Chavez came back out for a scoreless fifth, and senior Brandon Berl shut the door with two perfect innings, picking up three punch outs in the process.

For the Phoenix, junior Dorsey Ek and freshman Justin Rahn got through the sixth and seventh innings with 1-2-3 innings, but the damage had already been done. Channing was on base twice, drawing two walks, and Gastelum was a tough out all day at the plate. For the Gaels, Reynolds was on base three times with a walk in addition to his two hits, and played exceptional defense. Amerongen and Kalfus contributed two hits a piece, and Heinzer continued his strong play with two more hits of his own. **Chavez was named the game's most valuable player. He settled down after the third and did not run into trouble the rest of the day, finishing his outing with six strikeouts.**" (SMCGaels.com)
